CURRENT HIV PREVENTION LANDSCAPE

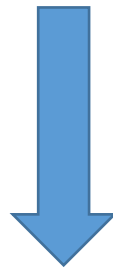
- PrEP

PROJECT GOALS

- To ensure that Higher Education students are included in the PrEP roll-out plans
- To ensure that campus health structures are sensitized on PrEP and other sexual and reproductive health services
- To activate student interest and activism around HIV prevention and more comprehensive reproductive healthcare services

Expected outcomes

- Higher Education students included in the PrEP roll-out policy
- Higher Education students having access to comprehensive sexual and reproductive health including PrEP
- Activated student activism around sexual and reproductive health rights

Anticipated challenges

- The DoH could be unable to provide sufficient PrEP to those in need due to budgetary or stock-outs issues
- Adolescent girls and young women having a discomfort with PrEP packaging
 - Stigma
 - Messaging not compelling
- Clinics are encouraging prevention seeking behaviour
