





Q3 Data – What We Know About Implementation




- South Africa reached 570,000 cumulative initiations, becoming the country with the greatest number of PrEP initiations in the world.
- Nigeria, Uganda, and Zambia exceeded 300,000 cumulative initiations.
- Mozambique and Zimbabwe broke 100,000 cumulative initiations in Q3 2022.
- USA exceeded 300,000 cumulative initiations, increasing by almost 136,000 initiations this year.
- Australia and Zimbabwe approved CAB




