

Research regulatory system in Uganda



Regulatory

• UNCST regulations considers Pregnant Women to be among the vulnerable group .

 It also specifies that with respect to research among pregnant women and fetuses, prior appropriate research in Animal models and non-pregnant women should have been completed (MTN-020 / ASPIRE).

Regulatory

 During the consenting process, a statement that a particular treatment or Procedure under study may involve risk to the research participant or to the embryo or fetus if the research participant is or May become pregnant, and that the risk is Currently unforeseeable – should be included.

Informed Consent by Pregnant Women

 For research involving pregnant women, informed consent should be obtained from <u>both</u> the mother and father of the embryos and fetuses.

Informed Consent by Pregnant Women

- However the father's consent Shall not be required if:-
- 1. the purpose of the research is primarily to meet the health needs Of the mother;
- 2. the father's identity and/or Whereabouts are unknown;
- 3. the father is not reasonably available;
- 4. the pregnancy resulted from rape or incest.
- 5. the father Is incompetent to give consent

Informed Consent by Pregnant Women

 No provision of this subsection shall be construed as authorization to terminate a pregnancy where such termination would not otherwise be in conformity with current Laws of Uganda relating to the termination of pregnancy.

Local Context.

- Most studies involving pregnant women are often observational or behavioral intervention in natural
- The few clinical trials conducted are often directly towards pregnancy related health conditions like PPH,
- Some interventional studies (e.g MOMS) have been successfully conducted.

Local Context.

- Besides research, pregnant women are considered "a special population" and generally respected and taken to be "delicate" by the society.
- Male partners play a role in women's decision hence their involvement is important.
